As with most of the subjects within the Humanities, English is adjusting to meet the needs of our students. Gone are the days when we can count on students enrolling in our classes only because they see an inherent value in writing well to succeed academically and to be more professional later in life. In the past century, that has been enough, but our relevance is no longer a given for all of our students. Creative Writing is one of the avenues that the

contemporary student has gravitated towards in our discipline. Offering more sections of our already popular class is a step toward meeting our students where they are so we can take them where they want to go.

Furthermore, curricula are stronger when varied opinions and viewpoints help form them. By having one more informed full time faculty member working with our current full time Creative Writing faculty, we have the potential of reaching more students from differing backgrounds than we currently do.

Finally, I have taught English at the college level for seventeen years, ten here at VC. Most likely, I have about seventeen more to go before I retire. I love my job here at VC more than I can say. I realize how lucky I am to work here. But since the end of Covid, I have sensed the fire burning inside smoldering a bit. I believe this time off to help me remember what it is I love English for, will help me. Also, by modeling the life of the writer for my students more convincingly, will allow me to be a more effective teacher. Quite frankly, without having a book length manuscript in my back pocket, even if it isn't published, makes me feel a bit like a fraud if I am to teach students Creative Writing.

Professional development: I will pursue coursework through UCLA Extension in their Creative Writing Certificate program. These two ten week courses will be worth 3 credits each.
