Under Board Policy and Administrative Procedure 3540 Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, and Stalking, the VCCCD prohibits any sexual assault or physical abuse, including the crimes of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking, as defined by California law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public, occurring on District property, in



Domestic Violence : Means committing a battery (misdemeanor) or willfully inflicting corporal injury resulting in a traumatic condition (felony) by:

- x a current or former spouse or intimate partner of the victim;
- x a person with whom the victim shares a child in common;

Risk reduction includes options designed to decrease perpetration and bystander inaction, and to increase empowerment for victims in order to promote safety and to help individuals and communities address conditions that facilitate violence.

- x Walk with friends or with others to and from classes. Contact the VCCCD Police Department for an escort at 805 -437-8444.
- x Be aware of your surroundings. Do not focus/text on your cell phone while walking.
- x Have your car keys ready. Do not focus your attention on searching through your purse/backpack. Check your backseat before entering your vehicle.
